This is a supplement to my earlier email about the changes in the procedure for summary judgment motions. There have been a few problems in cases where the two-week adjournment has been requested and granted.

In the event of a two week adjournment, Tom will provide both the adjournment date and the **DATE ON WHICH OPPOSING PAPERS MUST BE SERVED AND SUBMITTED TO THE COURT.**

On the **same day** the adjournment is granted, the opposing party must also notify the moving party (by fax or email) that an adjournment has been granted and the date by which its opposing papers are due.

The opposing party must submit and serve papers **by that date.**
