

The above-captioned matters are part of the July 2010 FIFO cluster referred to Part 12 by order of the Administrative Judge, Hon. Sherry Klein Heitler, dated September 10, 2010. Three cases part of the cluster scheduled to proceed to trial today, not captioned above, have settled. According to prior orders of this court, the *Robbins* and *Tucker* cases are schedule to proceed to trial next. If said cases are not completely resolved, counsel should be prepared to proceed to jury selection on Friday, July 1, 2011. However, given that many of the defendants in the

remaining cases in this cluster have already settled out of the cases, a reconsideration of how the remaining cases should or should not be joined and in what order they should proceed to trial is warranted. Therefore, all remaining parties in the above-captioned cases shall appear on July 1, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. fully authorized to discuss settlement, issues related to joinder, and to select trial dates with a view toward resolving this entire cluster prior to September 2011.
